School Crisis Counseling Support

Crises in schools can be rare and unexpected, they have the potential to undermine the safety and stability of the school and may make it difficult to protect students and staff. Free of charge, CREA can support your school's current crisis intervention plan in the event that additional support is needed. Licensed school counselor(s) may be available to advocate for all persons affected by the critical incident by providing counseling support services during and after the crisis.

School crisis or critical events may include any of the following:

- School Threat
- Death of Student
- Death of Faculty/Staff
- Transportation Accident
- Natural Disaster
- Other Incidents Deemed as a Crisis

To assist in the resulting needs and to diffuse and debrief with affected individuals, activities that can be facilitated by CREA school counselors include:

- Be available on site to interact with students and staff
- Assist with communication to parents/guardians
- Provide group and individual counseling
- Support students and staff needing assitance in their designated meeting space
